## ISIB is BridgeBuilding Contributor of 2022 Eurovent Summit

It aims at **#BuildingBridges** between manufacturers and consultants, planners, installers, trade associations and policymakers between Europe, the East and beyond, toward more sustainable and circular products and a more socially and environmentally responsible industry.

Highlights include the <u>Eurovent Innovation/HUB</u> focused on the link between innovation and sustainability, a high-level policy panel presenting visions for the future of product efficiency from different stakeholders, a special honorary event 'Legends of Eurovent', a panel discussion on the future of industry exhibitions in the post-pandemic world, and a parallel seminar programme organised by <u>ISKID</u> and <u>TTMD</u> (in English and Turkish).
