Background

- ECC active in India since 2019
- Member of Technical committees and working groups for Key Prescribers
- Eurovent members involved in standardisation
- Example: ISHRAE AHU standard based on EN
- Rising pressure from AHRI, direct engagement with prescribers
- Mounting member requests for more on ground presence

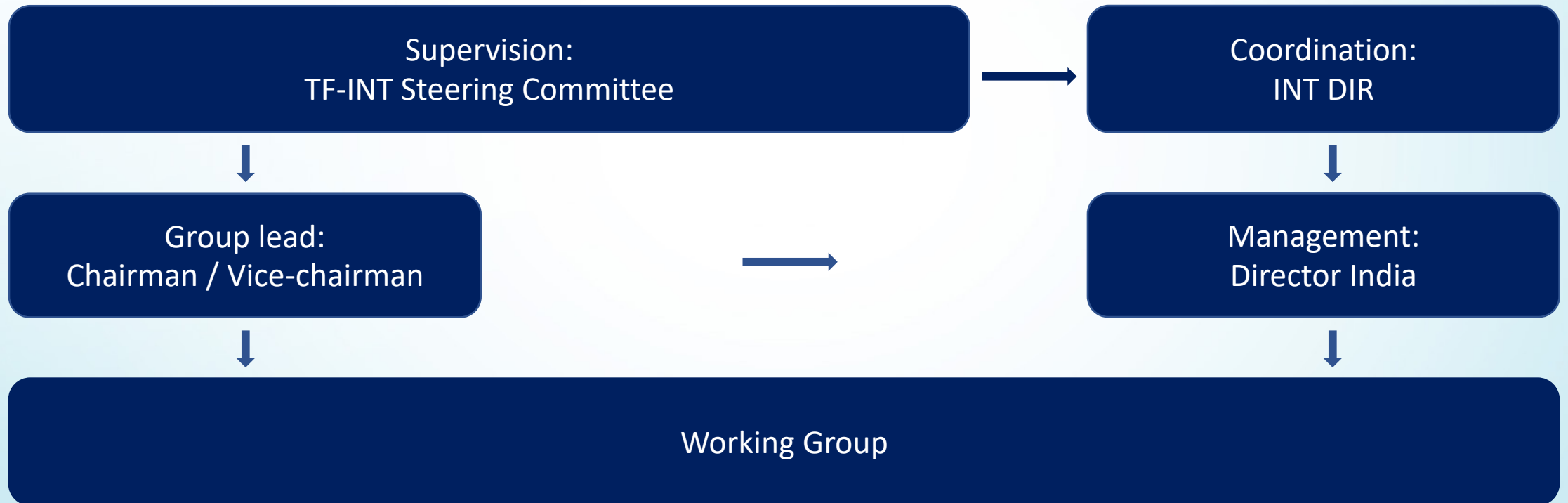
