Meeting notes

The meeting will close around 13:00h to allow those who need to go to the airport a timely closing. All other attendees are invited to join lunch at a nearby location on 31 May.

Dress code for the meeting is business casual. The current weather forecast predicts temperatures around 21 degrees. We recommend bringing a light jacket for the dinner cruise.

Practical advice

Czech Republic currently has suspended all entry requirements related to Covid-19. However please observe specific requirements by your airline.

Local currency is Czech Crowns (1 EUR = 24 CZK). When using ATMs to withdraw crowns, be aware that many ATMs suggest preselected amounts which tend to be extremely high (sometimes from 10.000 CZK upwards). Make sure to select 'other amount' to withdraw smaller sums.

We recommend using UBER, BOLT or other online taxi services.

Competition Law Rules

Because participants in Eurovent Product Groups, Issue Groups, Board, Commission, and related meetings are companies with competing, and sometimes opposing economic interests, the meetings are subject to close competition law (anti-trust) scrutiny.

Generally, all communication or discussions with possible direct influence on the decisions of individual companies regarding production levels, product pricing, marketing strategies, or selection of customers or suppliers must be avoided. The following areas shall not be discussed in the meetings:

- Price or any elements of price or pricing policies, including costs, discounts, rebates, profit margins, etc.
- Terms or conditions of sale, including warranties, credit, and shipping arrangements.
- Particular competitors, suppliers, or customers.
- Sales or production quotas or limits, allocation of customers or sales territories or refusal to sell to certain customers or to buy from certain suppliers.
- The market share or sales territory of any particular competitor.
- The operating statistics, inventories, sales, marketing methods, or strategies of any particular competitor.
- Controlling competition or excluding any competitor from any market.

By applying these measures, Eurovent stays in line with legal requirements.

Bribery and corruption

Eurovent and its members reject corruption and bribery as stated in the relevant UN Convention. We use suitable means to promote transparency, integrity, responsible leadership, and accountability.

Data protection

By attending this meeting, and in full accordance with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), participants authorise Eurovent to share contact information with majority owned subunits of the Eurovent Association as well as, in case of events organised by Eurovent, sponsors and partners.

Meeting participants furthermore consent to audio recording, video recording and photography, and authorise Eurovent to publish event-related photos and videos on its website and social media channels.
